



Curling Sheet Set-Up Steps

Once the “Zamboni” has left the ice...

1. Bring stones to their respective sheets.
2. From hockey bench area, bring:
 - a. scoreboards to far end of sheets;
 - b. gray bin with the scoreboard team name box to far end of sheets;
 - c. other gray bin to near end of sheets; and
 - d. rock box frame to near end of sheets.
 - e. Note, leave broom bin at hockey bench.
3. Distribute sliders and stabilizers from gray bins behind hacks on all ends of sheets.
4. Fill rock box (15 stones). Once the pebbler has made their 2nd pass, drag rock box over each sheet using two people (takes 2 passes to cover entire sheet).
5. After rock box passes, set green cones from gray bins on sheets.
6. With 2 people, move the wooden bench on the right of the warm room doors (when viewing from the ice) to the ice and place on the blue hockey goal crease at the near end.
