

Curling Sheet Set-Up Steps

Once the "Zamboni" has left the ice...

- 1. Bring stones to their respective sheets.
- 2. From hockey bench area, bring:
 - a. scoreboards to far end of sheets;
 - b. gray bin with the <u>scoreboard team name box</u> to <u>far end</u> of sheets;
 - c. other gray bin to near end of sheets; and
 - d. rock box frame to <u>near end</u> of sheets.
 - e. Note, leave broom bin at hockey bench.
- 3. Distribute sliders and stabilizers from gray bins behind hacks on all ends of sheets.
- 4. Fill rock box (15 stones). Once the pebbler has made their 2nd pass, drag rock box over each sheet using two people (takes 2 passes to cover entire sheet).
- 5. After rock box passes, set green cones from gray bins on sheets.
- 6. With 2 people, move the wooden bench on the right of the warm room doors (when viewing from the ice) to the ice and place on the blue hockey goal crease at the <u>near end</u>.
